This past fall we installed 11 ACVs and commissioned 3 ACVs in August while beginning our commissioning process of the other eight ACVs in January. ACV sizes for the two projects were 50,000 and 60,000 pounds respectively. With 48 ACVs in operation, our customers are seeing the benefits of working with APT and asking us to partner with them on other aspects of their cheese making process such as our Advanced Finishing Vats, CIP and Dosing Systems & Packaging Equipment.

With our team's focus on plant concept, design, process, electrical/ automation and mechanical engineering; along with equipment manufacturing, and complete installation, we are constantly busy working with customers to build systems that can do more with less. With a strong focus on delivering customized, efficient products.

Although the dairy industry comprises a large share of our business, we continue to expand in the food and beverage industry working in the honey, brewing and egg production segments, as well as, water treatment plants to diversify our customer base.
